


Rally Day

Sunday, August 6


We will be recognizing our Sunday School Teachers as they renew their commitment to teaching children. Also we recognize children who are entering first grade and award a bible.


This year, Jaden Choi is entering first grade.

We wish more could have come, but Remy was the only graduate who was able to participate. We congratulate all graduates and we pray for God's presence and guidance through all the steps of your life.






Youth Pastor Needed

Preserving the Historical Records of the Chinese Presbyterian Church

Your church was founded in 1882 as the Chinese Presbyterian Mission of New Orleans, and over the past 135 years, the mission and church has produced hundreds of annual reports, correspondences, and other documents, as well as thousands of photographs. These documents chronicle the entire history of your church and provide a vast source of information on the history of Chinese Americans in this city.

The objective of this project is to identify, put in order, and digitally scan as many records before 1982 and photographs as possible, so that they may be

preserved forever and made more accessible. This project will last into next year, though there are no long-term commitments for volunteers. This is an excellent service opportunity for high school and university students seeking service hours or something to put on a resume. No research experience is required.
